Other Changes to the Fare Structure

Local Service Day Pass

This advance-purchase pass is for unlimited Local rides during a single calendar day and is priced at \$4.50. It has a Local cash fare value of \$1.50 for credit on higher-priced services. The pass is only sold at RTD Sales Outlets and online and requires date validation by bus operators or at light rail validation machines.

Eco Pass

Pricing will increase 10% from current rates. Service Level Area designations will be adjusted in some areas.

Regular Service Day Pass

This advance-purchase pass is for unlimited Local, Express and Regional rides during a single calendar day (skyRide service excluded) and is priced at \$10.00. It has a Regional cash fare value of \$3.75 for credit on skyRide service. The pass is only sold at RTD Sales Outlets and online and requires date validation by bus operators or at light rail validation machines.

Neighborhood Eco Pass

Price per household will increase 10% from current rates.
