

Changes approved by the RTD Board of Directors  
for implementation prior to May service changes

**The changes listed below for the Routes 6X, T, W (70X) and P are currently scheduled to begin operation on Monday March 5, 2007. Draft schedules for each service are expected to be available no later than Monday February 19.**

Route 6X Ward Rd/Cold Spring/DTC Express – 2 trips in the morning peak will operate from the Ward Road park-n-Ride to the Cold Spring park-n-Ride to connect with the 6X service operating from there. Two trips will run the reverse in the afternoon. Beginning with the May service changes, these trips will be made a part of the regular Route 6X schedule, eliminating the need for a transfer.

Route T Boulder/DTC – 3 trips in the morning peak will operate from Table Mesa park-n-Ride following the same route as previously operated, serving Ulster/Tufts and terminating at Arapahoe. 3 return trips will operate in the afternoon peak. This route will connect with the Route 70X (a portion of the former Route W) at the 70<sup>th</sup> and Broadway park-n-Ride on two trips in each direction.

Route 70X (formerly W) Wagon Rd/DTC – 2 trips will serve the Wagon Road and Thornton park-n-Rides with a timed connection with the Route T at the 70<sup>th</sup> & Broadway park-n-Ride. 2 return trips will operate in the afternoon peak. The route will be renamed the 70X since it will no longer be a Regional service.

Route P Franktown/Parker/Denver – 5 trips will operate in the am peak serving the previous Route P alignment, eliminating the stop at I-25 and Broadway. 5 trips will operate in the reverse direction in the afternoon peak.

At this time, reductions in service frequencies on the Routes 410 and 410L that are associated with the partial resumption of service on the Route P are not expected to take place until the May service changes take effect. However, Routes 410/410Ltd will be changed to begin and end at the Pinery (instead of Franktown) at the same time as the resumption of service on Route P.
