RTD is suspending all rail and bus service at 7 p.m. today due to blizzard conditions

Customers should look to RTD channels for the latest information on when service will resume

DENVER (March 14, 2021) – The Regional Transportation District ([RTD](#)) is suspending all bus and rail services at 7 p.m. today due to treacherous blizzard conditions and road closures throughout the metro area. The agency made the decision for the safety of its customers and employees, and will work to accommodate customers on the system in the meantime.

Service will resume when conditions improve. Multiple buses stuck throughout the day and freezing rail equipment have made it difficult to provide service as conditions worsened. RTD will monitor the situation and determine when to resume service based on conditions and safety. The agency will communicate this information as soon as it is available.

Safety is RTD's top priority, and the agency's ultimate goal is to get everyone safely to their destinations. Many municipalities and agencies across the Denver metro region are discouraging all travel unless it is critical.
