### RTD hosts telephone town halls to discuss fares, adjustments to services, project updates and answer questions

DENVER (Oct. 25, 2021) – The [Regional Transportation District \(RTD\)](#) Board of Directors and RTD leadership is hosting a series of telephone town halls in October and November in each of the 15 districts in its service area.

Residents are invited to join the dialogue to discuss and provide input on key topics affecting the agency, including the status of services as we move through COVID-19, the recommendations from Reimagine RTD which affect future build back of service, the fare study and equity analysis, and more. The forum will also answer questions from the listening audience.
