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RTD to hold virtual public meetings for proposed May 2022 service changes

The three meetings will be hosted to discuss service adjustments and gather public input

DENVER (Jan. 26, 2022) – Customers of the [Regional Transportation District \(RTD\)](#) will have the opportunity to provide feedback about RTD’s proposed service changes that will go into effect in May 2022. Virtual meetings will be held Feb. 3, 7 and 8. To see the changes RTD is proposing, [visit the website](#).

This service change proposal represents seasonal adjustments to improve on-time performance and support changes in ridership. In addition to these service changes, RTD will present information on the Reimagine RTD draft System Optimization Plan (SOP) which includes recommendations for service redesign and provides a route-by-route guide for service development between late 2022 and 2027. The SOP is available for public review and input through the [Reimagine RTD website](#) through Feb. 9.
