

## **Masks remain required on RTD services through May 3**

*Federal mandate extended 15 days, in light of rise in cases of new coronavirus variant*

DENVER (April 13, 2022) – The [Regional Transportation District \(RTD\)](#) continues to require that its customers and employees wear a face mask on RTD vehicles, in agency facilities and while waiting at stops and stations, in accordance with the Transportation Security Administration (TSA)'s extension of the federal mask mandate for all transportation networks through May 3.

The 15-day extension follows an order from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), which noted a rise in cases earlier this month of a new coronavirus variant. The current mandate was to have remained in effect through Monday, April 18. RTD will continue to adhere to the CDC guidelines and TSA requirements pertaining to the mandate.
