

RTD to support Independence Day events this weekend with additional capacity on light rail service to downtown

RTD Service Alerts, Next Ride apps provide real-time updates, best transit options to reach events

DENVER (July 1, 2022) — To accommodate several Independence Day events this weekend, the [Regional Transportation District \(RTD\)](#) will add extra train cars to D, E, H and W light rail lines from Friday through Sunday. RTD bus and rail services will operate on regular schedules, and customers are encouraged to plan their trips ahead of time.

Events occurring downtown this weekend include:

- Fireworks displays at Coors Field following Friday and Saturday Rockies baseball games (games start at 6:10 p.m. Friday and 7:10 p.m. Saturday)
- Sunday, July 3 at Civic Center Park (gates open at 4 p.m.; fireworks start 9:15-9:30 p.m.)
- FAN EXPO Denver at the Colorado Convention Center, Friday-Sunday
- Chris Stapleton concerts at Ball Arena, 7 p.m. Saturday and Sunday
