RTD to sound train horns early Thursday at 100th Avenue crossing for N Line

N Line neighbors,

Starting at 11:30 p.m., Wednesday, June 8, and continuing through 5 a.m. on Thursday, June 9, the [Regional Transportation District \(RTD\)](#) will install and test an update to the software technology at the 100th Avenue crossing for the N Line. The work will take place during off-peak hours.

Crews will validate the technology using a test train through the crossing. Per federal requirement, train horns will sound through the crossing during this part of the work.

RTD recognizes that this work can be disruptive and apologizes for the resulting sound the public may hear.

While testing is underway, please remember to obey traffic signs and safety measures in place. Train operators maintain discretion to use train horns under circumstances requiring additional safety precautions and may sound horns at crossings beyond those stated above.

Quiet crossings will resume once the work is complete, with trains using horns only when necessary for safety.
