

Weekend work at I-25•Broadway Station to affect RTD light rail service

Customers urged to plan alternate routes during overhead wire replacement north of Englewood Station

DENVER (July 7, 2022) — The [Regional Transportation District \(RTD\)](#) will perform necessary maintenance that will affect light rail service on the D Line north of Englewood Station **Saturday and Sunday, July 9-10**. The scheduled work will improve reliability and safety along the line.

During the work, the **D Line will not operate north of Englewood Station, and there will be no rail service to or from Evans Station**. Work is being performed to replace overhead wires at I-25•Broadway Station beginning at **12:01 a.m. Saturday, July 9**. Regular service on the D Line will resume **Monday, July 11**.

Customers whose trips are impacted by the rail closure are encouraged to park at I-25•Broadway Station to access the E and H lines, with service to and from downtown, or to explore the use of bus routes 0 and 21.

RTD's C Line rail service remains suspended in accordance with the agency's COVID-19 service plan.
