be safe around buses and trains

At RTD, safety is a top priority. Please take a moment to review the following safety tips with your family to ensure their safety and the safety of the community:

- The wires above the train are extremely high voltage. Do not try to touch or throw objects at them.
- Only cross the tracks at designated crossings and never walk, bike or play along the tracks.
- All crossings have warning signs like flashing red lights and gate arms. Wait until the gates fully rise before crossing.
- Always look both ways before crossing the tracks. Trains can come from either direction at any time and are surprisingly quiet.
- Avoid listening to music or using your cell phone while around trains.
- Never sit on the platform edge or touch the outside of a train.
- While waiting for the train, always stand behind the yellow platform line. Wait for the train to stop and the doors to open before approaching the train.
- Watch your step getting on and off the train. There is a small gap between the platform edge and the train.
- Remain seated while the train is moving and hold on at all times if you have to stand.
